HELMETS REQUIRED FOR JUNIOR DRIVERS AND ENCOURAGED FOR ALL

SHOW DIVISIONS: Championship and Reserve shall be awarded in each division:

- **VSE (mini)/Small Pony:** 9.2 hands and under (singles and pairs)
- **Pony:** Over 9.2 hands; under 14.2 hands (singles and pairs)
- **Horse:** 14.2 hands and over (singles and pairs)
- **Green:** Either horse or driver has little show driving experience.

MUST DECLARE DIVISION ON ENTRY FORM. MORE THAN ONE DRIVER MAY USE THE SAME HORSE (WITH A SEPARATE ENTRY) IF THEY ARE ENTERING DIFFERENT CLASSES. OPEN OR GREEN CLASSES MAY BE ENTERED BY ANY SIZE. POINTS EARNED IN OPEN CLASSES WILL APPLY TO CHAMPIONSHIP/RESERVE CHAMPIONSHIP IN THE SIZE DIVISION THAT THE EQUINE IS ENTERED IN.

ALL EQUINES ARE WELCOME, just enter appropriate size/experience category.

Entry Fees: \$10/\$12* a class; \$5 per class for ground drivers & juniors (18 and under) (*Second fee listed is non-TVW member fee). **Stalls:** \$35/weekend (Friday 6 pm - Monday 9 am); **Electrical hook-ups:** \$10/day

Awards: Ribbons 1st - 4th each class; Champion and Reserve Champion awards for each division.

SATURDAY MORNING
INDOOR ARENA at 9:00 am

Turnout: To be judged primarily on the performance and quality of each turnout. To be shown both ways of the arena at a walk, slow trot, working trot and strong trot. To stand quietly and to rein back. Judged: 70% on the condition, fit and appropriateness of the harness and vehicle, neatness and appropriateness of attire and overall impression. 30% on performance, manners, and way of going.

1. Turnout - VSE/Small pony
2. Turnout - Pony
3. Turnout - Horse

Working: To be judged primarily on the suitability of the horse to provide a pleasant drive. To be shown both ways of the arena at a walk, slow trot, working trot and strong trot. To stand quietly, both on the rail and while lined up, and to rein back. Judged: 70% on performance, manners and way of going of the horse(s); 20% on the condition and fit of the harness and vehicle; 10% on neatness of attire.

4. Working - VSE/Small pony
5. Working - Pony
6. Working - Horse

Super Reinsmanship: Competitors enter the ring individually, complete figures at a prescribed pace and negotiate a few cones set in a small course. The competitors receive a numerical score, 80% of which is based on handling of reins and whip, control, posture and overall appearance of the driver, 20% based on conditions of harness, vehicle and neatness of attire, There will be a 5-point penalty for each ball displaced.

ADS Test Pattern #1 will be used.

7. Super Reinsmanship - open

LUNCH BREAK - Bring your own lunch

“Ground Floor” pleasure: Competitors enter the ring on long reins at a walk. To be judged on the calmness and obedience of the horse, and the skill of the driver. To be shown both ways of the arena at a walk only. To stand quietly. No cross-entry with classes 1-9 but may enter both classes 10 and 11.

8. “Ground Floor” Pleasure - Green, ground driving

“Training Wheels” pleasure: Competitors enter the ring individually, harnessed but not put to a vehicle. To be judged on the calmness, manners, and obedience of the horse, and the skill of the driver. Each driver must have a minimum of one helper. Horse is to be put to a suitable vehicle in the arena and is to be shown both ways of the arena at a walk. Trotting is at the discretion of the driver and the judge. Not to back. To halt and stand quietly while vehicle is removed. No cross-entry with classes 1-7 but may enter both classes 8 and 9.

9. “Training Wheels” Pleasure - Green

Musical Freestyle: Competitors select music and choreograph their own patterns and compete individually. Costumes are optional. To be judged on performance, appropriateness of music to turnout, inclusion of required elements, and overall impression. Halt and salute at beginning and end of routine. “Ground floor” ground drivers must include: A. Walk; B. Trot; and C. Halt. Each gait to be performed both ways of the arena. Strong trot, reinback, and lateral movements may be included at the discretion of the driver. Open drivers must include: A. Walk; B. Trot; C. Strong trot; D. Halt; and E. Reinback. 4-minute time limit. Competitor must furnish own music on a CD. No cross-entry between classes 10 and 11.

10. Musical Freestyle - “Ground floor”- Green, ground driving
11. Musical Freestyle - open

SUNDAY MORNING
INDOOR ARENA at 9:00 am

Cones - "Ground Floor": Ground driving cones/obstacle driving class. Walk or trot. A pre-set course will be set up and timed. Course penalties added to time. Lowest score wins.

12. "Ground Floor" Cones - Green. No cross-entry with 14,15,16.

Cones - "Training Wheels": An easy pre-set course will be set up and timed, with very wide clearances. Walk or trot. Course penalties added to time. Lowest score wins.

13. "Training Wheels" cones - Green. No cross-entry with 14,15,16. May hitch in arena.

Cones - Timed: Traditional cones/obstacle driving class. Trotting only. A pre-set course will be set up and timed. Minimum clearance will be announced or posted. Course penalties added to time. Lowest score wins. **HORSES MAY BE SHARED BETWEEN DIVISIONS; DRIVERS MAY GO AS GROOMS WITH ANOTHER TURNOUT**

- 14. Timed Cones - VSE/Small pony
- 15. Timed Cones - Pony
- 16. Timed Cones - Horse

Cones - Double Jeopardy: Entry consists of two drivers in one carriage. Trotting only. First driver goes through the start and drives the course to the finish marker. Time is paused for driver change. After passing the finish marker and coming to a COMPLETE HALT, the second driver takes the reins and drives back through the start/finish, through the course backwards and again through the start/finish markers. The reverse course will be marked with numbers on different colored markers. Best time wins: course penalties are to be added to the time. Failure to come to a complete stop to change drivers may result in a 10 second penalty at the judge's discretion. **DRIVERS MAY BE SHARED AND GO MORE THAN ONCE ON THE COURSE.**

Lunch Break - Bring your own lunch

Cones - Town and Country Cones course with objects beside cones that might be encountered on a drive out in the country or the town. Walk or trot. Minimum clearance will be announced or posted. Course penalties added to time. Lowest score wins. This will have a Halloween theme.

- 20. Town and Country - "Ground floor" - Green. No cross-entry with 21,22,23.
- 21. Town and Country - VSE/Small pony
- 22. Town and Country - Pony
- 23. Town and Country - Horse
